The Hope School of Spokane, WA

Located in Spokane, WA on the Washington State University/Eastern Washington University campus, the HOPE (Hearing Oral Program of Excellence) operates a pre-school and toddler program for children with hearing impairments. Funding for the school helps offset operational expenses and scholarships for students whose families cannot afford the special education services. The school is also a clinical site for speech pathology and special education majors studying at Eastern Washington University. Primarily funded by the Oberkotter Foundation of Philadelphia, the HOPE school mission is "Building Bright Futures for Children with Hearing Loss", and provides excellent "listening and spoken language" studies for young children wearing cochlear implants, hearing aids and other assistive listening devices.
